**DECLARATION OF CLASS COUNSEL IN SUPPORT OF
PLAINTIFFS' UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY APPROVAL
OF CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT**

The undersigned hereby declare as follows:

1. The parties have been litigating this matter for nearly a decade.
2. Over that time, the parties engaged in extensive discovery, involving thousands of pages of documents.
3. On November 20, 2025, the Illinois Supreme Court, in *Fausett v. Walgreen Co.*, 2025 IL 13144, ruled that “plaintiff lacked standing to bring her FACTA violation claim and thus the granting of class certification was erroneous.” *Id.* at ¶ 54.
4. The Settlement Agreement was executed by the parties in this action before the *Fausett* decision and therefore survives that ruling. Moreover, considering the uncertainty during mediation that *Fausett* caused for both sides, the Settlement is not subject to revocation based on changes in the law.
5. Given *Fausett*, had Plaintiffs not settled, they and the Class would have recovered nothing.

6. Accordingly, the Settlement is necessarily and undeniably in the best interests of the Class.
